
Fall 2019 The Montessori Circle

Fall Highlights:

The Five Great Lessons: The Great Lessons are an important part of the Montessori curriculum and are designed to awaken a child's imagination and curiosity. They include the Coming of the Universe and Earth, Coming of Life, Coming of Humans, Communication in Signs, and the Story of Numbers.

MSBG was founded in 1980 under the name Nazarene Montessori School. Full-day Kindergarten was added in 1986. In the spring of 1990 the school's name changed to The Montessori School of Bowling Green to better reflect the programs and services offered. That fall, the elementary and extended-day programs opened, and then the Middle School program. The Toddler program opened in the Fall of 2018 for ages 18 months through 3 years.
